POWER AND WATER CORPORATION

Discoloured water in the Darwin region

Discoloured water can be linked to a number of causes one of which is the weather mixing the layers of water in our reservoir at Darwin River Dam. The deeper levels containing higher levels of iron and manganese mix with the upper levels and enter the water supply system.

Discoloured water generally occurs intermittently during November to May. When it enters the reticulation system it will cause some immediate nuisance aesthetic problems but the iron and manganese can settle in water pipes and is mobilised in drier periods when increased flows are sufficient to stir it up.

It may appear yellowish to brownish in the initial part of the Wet Season and reddish to black towards the start of the Dry Season. You might notice it in white baths and basins. In all but the most severe cases the risk of illness from consumption is low. It may cause staining of white laundry and stained laundry should be kept wet and treated with a stain remover or dishwashing detergent.
