LIQUOR ACT
1st NOTICE OF APPLICATION
FOR A VARIATION OF LIQUOR LICENCE
VIVA LA VIDA WINE AND TAPAS BAR

Fatchops Pty Ltd, hereby give notice that it has applied to the Director-General of Licensing for a variation to the Liquor Licence conditions for Viva la Vida Wine and Tapas Bar, located at Shop M19 and M18B, Paspalis Centre Point Building, 48 - 50 Smith Street Mall, Darwin NT.

PROPOSED VARIATION OF LIQUOR LICENCE CONDITIONS are as follows:

\* Change of Authority from an "On" Licence to a "Tavern" Licence

\* Extend trading hours
The current trading hours are as follows:
11:30 hours to 02:00 hours, seven (7) days a week.

Proposed trading hours:
10:00 hours to 02:00 hours (the following day), seven (7) days a week.

\* Variation of Concept condition
The current concept condition:

This licence allows for one (1) quality restaurant and ancillary bar. The premises shall at all times have the predominant appearance of and shall trade principally as a restaurant where persons may consume alcohol without the requirement of consuming a meal.

The proposed concept condition:
The concept and atmosphere of the premises is that of an internal cocktail bar and alfresco dining area where quality food, beverages and service are on offer throughout the premises.

\* Variation of Alfresco Area condition
The current Alfresco Area condition:

All patrons within the alfresco area must be seated in order to promote the restaurant concept. There shall be no high tables or bar stools in the alfresco area. The alfresco area is to be occupied in accordance with Council's Policy 011, Outdoor Dining.

The proposed Alfresco Area condition:
There shall be no high tables or bar stools in the alfresco area and trade shall predominantly be as an outdoor dining area. Persons may consume alcohol without the requirement of consuming a meal. The alfresco area is to be occupied in accordance with Council's Policy 011, Outdoor Dining.

\* Variation of Functions condition
The current Functions condition:

The Licensee may from time to time utilise the inside licensed area as a function area. For functions that do not include the provision of a meal, snack foods are to be offered to all persons in attendance. 'Offered' is to be interpreted as the actual offer of food by way of wait person service to persons attending or by way of a buffet dedicated to the approved function. Patrons are permitted to stand inside the licensed premises during an organised function.

The proposed Functions condition:

The Licensee may utilise the inside licensed area as a function area where patrons are permitted to stand during an organised function.

The Applicant further requests the inclusion of the following licence conditions:

\* Music condition
Proposed Music condition:

Live music/entertainment predominately on Friday and Saturday nights with the ability to do so on any other night by way of; live band (i.e. solo, duo, trio), DJ, specialist performers (i.e. swing dancers, Latino, reggae, jazz) or pre-recorded music. Music will be above normal background noise. There shall be no designated dance floor.

\* Mobile Bar
Proposed Mobile Bar condition:

The Licensee may utilise one mobile bar within the licensed area between 10:00 and 02:00 hours the following day.

This is the first notice of application. The notice will be published again on Friday, 21 August 2015.

The objection period is deemed to commence from Friday, 21 August 2015. (date of publication of second notice).

Pursuant to Section 47F(2) of the Liquor Act an objection may only be made on the ground that the grant of the licence may or will adversely affect:

- (a) the amenity of the neighbourhood where the premises the subject of the application are or will be located; or
(b) the health, education, public safety or social conditions in the community.

Only those persons, organisations or groups described in Section 47F(3) of the Liquor Act may make an objection. Section 47G of the Liquor Act requires the Director-General of Licensing to inform the applicant of the substance of any objection. This will include the identity and where relevant the address of the objector.
