Reporting to the Business Transition Manager the Senior Support Coordinator will take a lead role in the development of a support coordination framework in readiness for the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) rollout in the Northern Territory. They will also champion the provision of support to participants, their families and carers in identifying and connecting with appropriate providers to support participants in the achievement of the objectives of their NDIS Plan.

Possessing qualifications in a mental health or disability support area, the successful applicant will have a demonstrated understanding of person-centred and strength based approaches, knowledge of NDIS, proven organisational and communication skills and a skilled problem solver.
